

Stop All

IMPORTANT: This device requires Max for Live which is included in Ableton Live Suite 10, but not the Intro or Standard versions. You can purchase Max for Live separately from the official Ableton website.

Installation Instructions

1. Download the .amxd file
2. Copy the .amxd file to your Max For Live user library 'Audio Effects' folder location.

On a Mac this folder is located at:

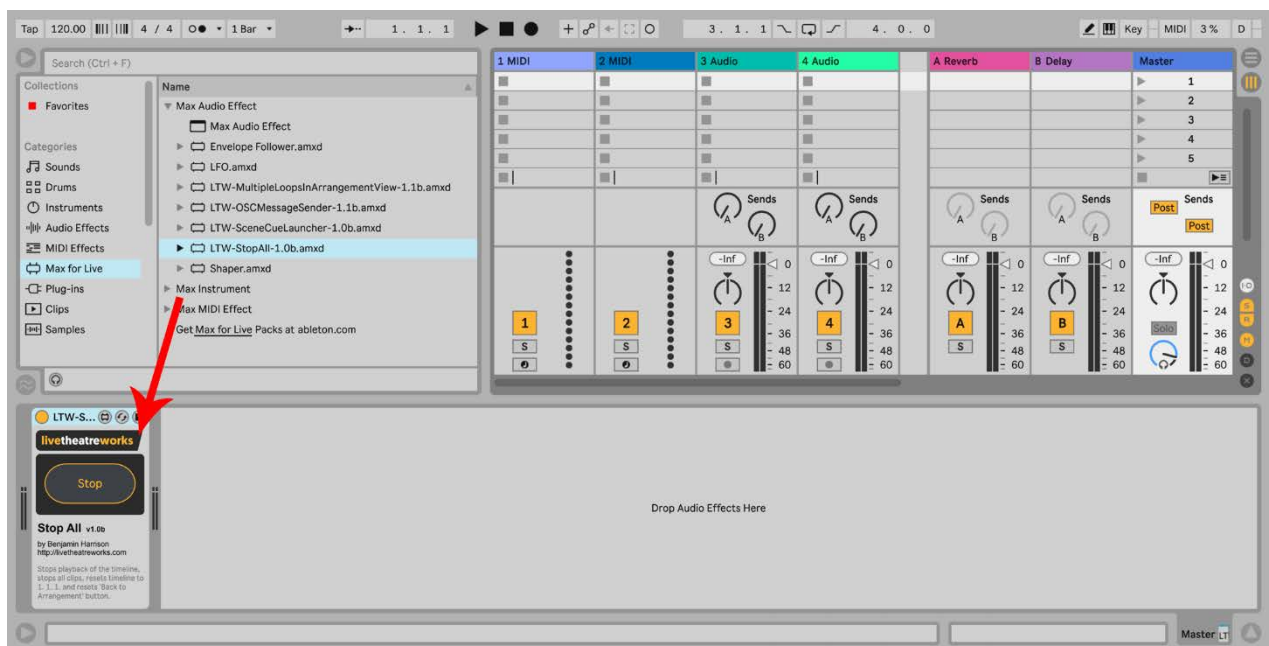
Macintosh HD/Users/[username]/Music/Ableton/User Library Presets/Audio Effects/Max Audio Effect

On a PC this folder is located at:

\Users[username]\Documents\Ableton\User Library\Presets\Audio Effects\Max Audio Effect

IMPORTANT: If you have specified a custom location for your User Library in Ableton Live's preferences, just follow the folder path after 'User Library' for where to place the .amxd file.

3. Open the Ableton Live application, navigate to the 'Max For Live' folder under 'Categories' in the left sidebar and open the 'Max Audio Effect' folder.
4. Drag the .amxd file to your 'Master' track.



Once the '**LWTW-StopAll**' .amxd file has been added to your Ableton Live master track, you can start using it in arrangement and/or session view.

Usage Instructions

- Clicking the 'Stop' button will stop all clips playing, stop the main timeline, reset the 'Back to Arrangement' button and reset the timeline back to the start.
- The 'Stop' button can be MIDI or Key mapped. For more information on how to map controls, please refer to the Ableton Live manual section **27. MIDI and Key Remote Control**
